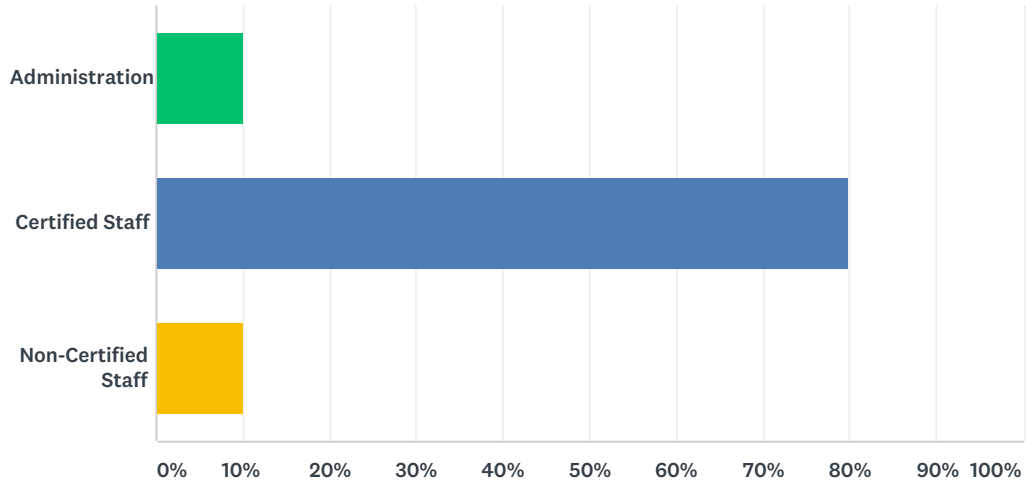

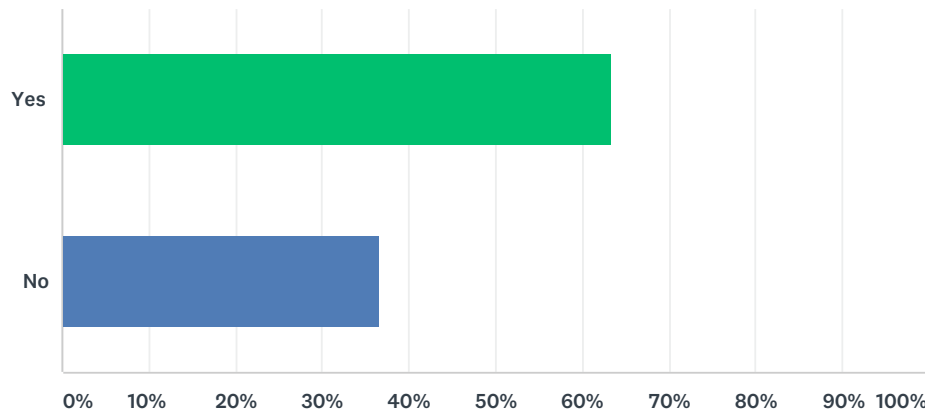

Q2 Based on what you know about the Future Ready Plan; would you support a district-wide IB Program for all students?

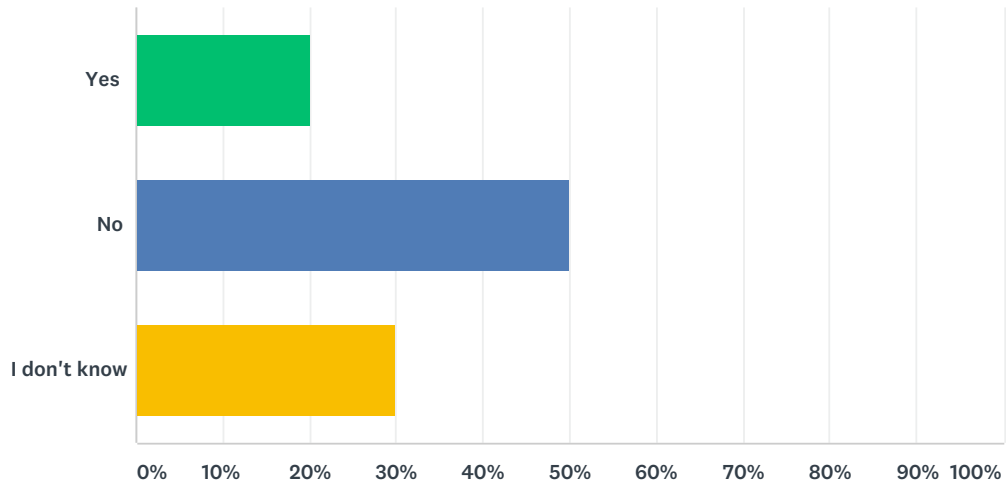

Q3 Do you believe CSK students are better prepared for middle school?

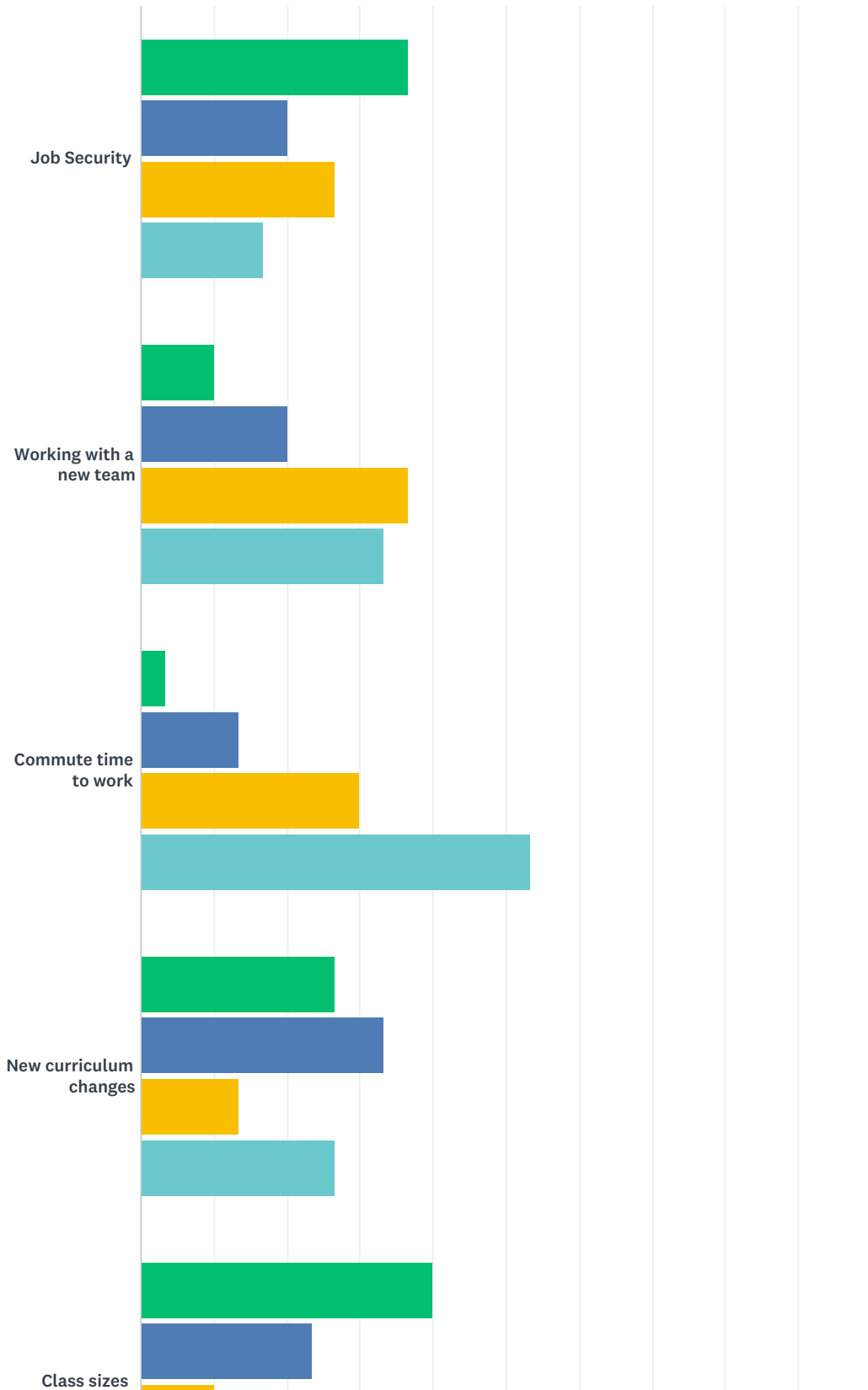

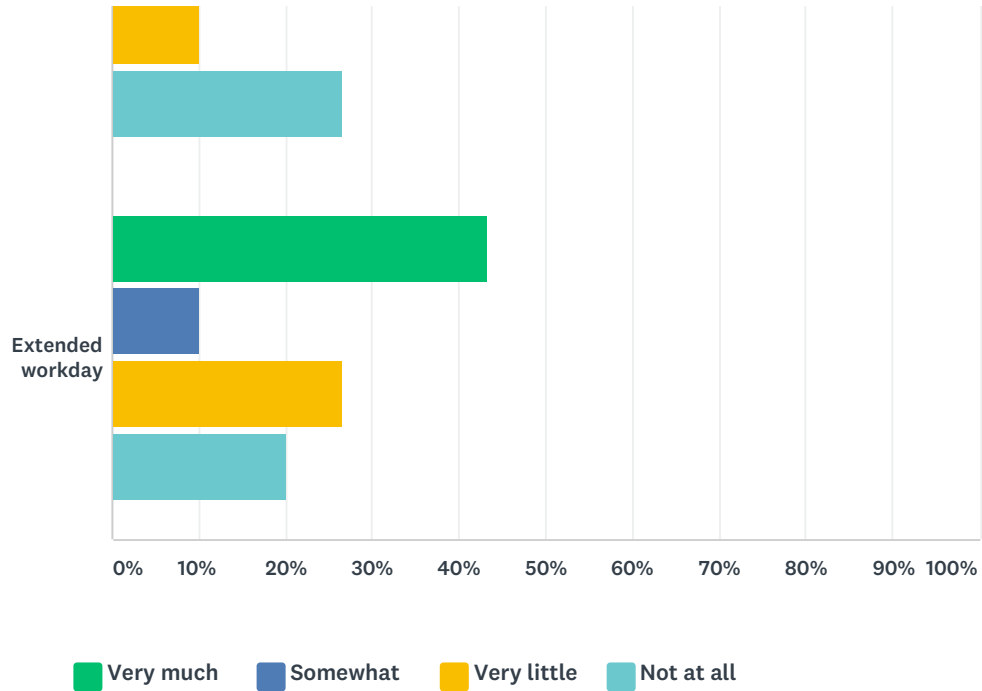
